

Waiver of Liability Relating to Coronavirus/COVID-19

The novel coronavirus, COVID-19, has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. COVID-19 is reported to be extremely contagious. The state of medical knowledge is evolving, but the virus is believed to spread from person-to-person contact and in the air. It is not possible to prevent against the presence of the disease. Therefore, if you choose to utilize The Boothbay Railway Village’s services and/or enter onto The Railway Village’s premises you may be exposing yourself to and/or increasing your risk of contracting or spreading COVID-19.

ASSUMPTION OF RISK: I have read and understood the above warning concerning COVID-19. We hereby choose to accept the risk of contracting COVID-19 for myself and/or my guests to utilize The Boothbay Railway Village’s services and enter The Boothbay Railway Village’s premises. These services are of such value to me and/or my guests, that we accept the risk of being exposed to, contracting, and/or spreading COVID-19 in order to utilize The Railway Village’s services and premises in person.

WAIVER OF LAWSUIT/LIABILITY: I hereby forever release and waive my right to bring suit against The Boothbay Railway Village and its owners, officers, directors, managers, officials, trustees, agents, employees, or other representatives in connection with exposure, infection, and/or spread of COVID-19 related to utilizing The Railway Village’s services and premises. I understand that this waiver means we give up our right to bring any claims including for personal injuries, death, disease or property losses, or any other loss, including but not limited to claims of negligence and give up any claim we may have to seek damages, whether known or unknown, foreseen or unforeseen.

CHOICE OF LAW: I understand and agree that the law of the State of Maine will apply to this contract.
